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### COVENT GARDEN LAUNCHES FAMILY FRIENDLY FEBRUARY HALF TERM FESTIVAL

- *Covent Garden is bringing a Family Food Festival to the Piazza this February*
- *An array of irresistible food offers, children's dining menus and entertaining pop ups will launch across the estate, providing fun for the whole family over Half Term and beyond*
- *Covent Garden will bring magic to its visitors with an exclusive **Harry Potter Butterbeer Bar** on the Piazza in celebration of the estate's Harry Potter Photographic Exhibition*
- *A new **public art** initiative will see an **al fresco community dining area** designed by London-based artist **Coco Lom** popping up on the Piazza*
- *Covent Garden's **Feast It food trucks** will see **Copper Penny, Crepe Masters and Pabellon** showcase a line-up of day to night food treats, from morning coffees to evening cocktails*
- ***Pancake Day** celebrations showcasing the best pancakes across the estate*

From 16<sup>th</sup> February **Covent Garden** will launch its very first **Family Food Festival**. The festival will see an exciting selection of innovative food pop ups, family friendly activities and exclusive food and drink offerings at restaurants across the estate throughout Half Term and into March, and a huge selection of pancakes for Pancake Day.

For fans of the much-loved book and film series and Covent Garden's **Harry Potter Photographic Exhibition**, a spellbinding **Harry Potter Butterbeer bar** will pop up and spark joy across the Piazza from 17<sup>th</sup> February, serving bottled Butterbeer and Harry Potter themed cupcakes to visitors, in a magical installation. Free souvenir tankards will be offered to anyone who purchases a bottle of Butterbeer from the pop up and then goes onto buy a ticket to the Exhibition.

To celebrate the launch of the Family Food Festival, Covent Garden will install a **brand new al fresco community dining area on the Piazza**, designed by London-based artist [Coco Lom](#). The al fresco area will be transformed with '*Blissful Benches*' - bespoke hand painted picnic tables in Lom's signature bold shapes and bright coloured prints and patterns, emblazoned with uplifting messages including 'Euphoria', 'Togetherness', 'Laughter' and 'Celebration'. There are eight separate designs to discover and the benches will be in situ from 17<sup>th</sup> February.

The hottest street food offers from **Feast It** will also be popping up across the Piazza from 16<sup>th</sup> February - 1<sup>st</sup> March with offerings that cater for families to office workers seeking a new lunch spot and beyond. Food and drink offers will span coffees and pastries from **Copper Penny**, family friendly lunches from **Pabellon, The Duck Shed** and **Crepe Masters**, sweet treats by **Jesseco, Prosecco & Pancakes**, and evening cocktails by **Free Wheelin** and **Honest Folk** to finish off the day in style, with all available to eat on the new al fresco dining area.

For families looking for pancakes ahead of pancake day, Covent Garden offers one of London's largest and most innovative selections, including American style pancakes and crepes at restaurants across the estate. Highlights include Macha pancakes from **AVOBAR**, Hot Buttermilk Pancakes courtesy of **The Ivy Market Grill** and **Balthazar** will serve their much loved New York style banana and blueberry buttermilk pancakes. Other favourites include **Crème de la Crêpe's** delicious sweet & savoury Crêpes and **Ave Mario's** Chantilly cream and banana buttermilk pancakes.

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The Family Food Festival will spotlight Covent Garden's wide range of family dining options and children's menus at all budgets. **Sticks'n'Sushi** offers a fantastic value for money kids menu and in-restaurant activities to keep young visitors entertained as well as a contest where they can receive chocolates for their entire class at school, while **Pitaya** offers a bespoke children's menu of hero 'Little Pitaya' dishes including chicken or vegetable main, a fruit drink and apple dessert. There are also family friendly menus at Covent Garden favourites **Balthazar, Shake Shack, Frenchie, The Ivy Market Grill, Avobar, Lilly's** and **The Gentlemen Baristas**.

Sitting alongside Covent Garden's food offering, the neighbourhood will play host to a range of family friendly activities providing children with fun and educational ways to stay entertained this half term. Visitors can explore **The London Transport Museum** and its new exhibition, *Legacies: London Transport's Caribbean Workforce*, which opens on 11 February and celebrates the generations of Caribbean people that have shaped London's transport history and culture. The museum will also offer activities including a Flag Exhibit, storytelling sessions and creative poster making throughout the week, with local resident discounts and kids go free offers available.

Other options for a Half Term day out include tech workshops at **Apple**, the **Harry Potter Photographic Exhibition**, ear piercing at **The Alkemystry**, a variety of shows at **Covent Garden's theatres**, and Family Sundays at **The Royal Opera House**. A cultural corner of London, theatregoers and art enthusiasts are spoilt for choice with the National Gallery, British Museum and Somerset House only a short walk away.

Half Term will also see the return of the successful **Pollock's gift bags**, which will provide young visitors the opportunity to select their own toys from the old-fashioned counter. The retailer has also teamed up with broadcaster and author Zeb Soanes and will be stocking signed copies of his latest book 'Gaspard's Foxtrot'.
