Covent Garden is a must-visit destination this February, offering a range of day-to-night activities and memorable experiences for the entire family to enjoy. Throughout the month, activities include a new **Month of Musicals** campaign, **Valentine's Day** date nights, as well as exciting **half-term activities** - all making Covent Garden a one-stop destination in the heart of London.

For the first time, Covent Garden will celebrate a **Month of Musicals** in partnership with the *Society of London Theatre*, celebrating the district's home as the birthplace of London theatre. Throughout the month the estate will come alive with interactive installations from some of London's most loved musicals including **Phantom of the Opera**, **Disney's Frozen** and **Matilda the Musical**. Visitors can experience London's most haunting love story '**The Phantom of the Opera**' at the red rose flower wall on the West Piazza; dare to take a seat on Miss Trunchbull's dreaded chair of doom from **Matilda the Musical** located in the Market Building's Central Avenue and enjoy **Disney's Frozen** takeover of the estate's iconic swing seat, themed around the '*Love is an open door*' hit number from the show.

For the celebration, guides to the best pre-theatre and family-friendly restaurants in the neighbourhood have been created by award winning food influencer Clerkenwell Boy, as part of the *Covent Garden Good Food Club*. Pre-theatre set menu options are also available at **VyTa**, **Frenchie**, **Mrs Riot** and **The Petersham**. Clerkenwell Boy approved family-friendly restaurants in the area include **Sticks'n'Sushi**, **Tuttons**, **Din Tai Fung**, **and Flat Iron**.

Launching this month, **Mrs Riot** will be hosting a ticketed event, *Musical Mondays*, where visitors can sing along with West End stars whilst they drink and dine. They can also sip on theatre-themed cocktails with the *Dirty Dancing Daiquiri* and *Juliet Lychee Loverboy* or explore others on the estate such as **Balthazar's** *Cabaret in Paris*, **Cora Pearl's** *The Cora Can Can*, and a *West Side Sake* from **SUSHISAMBA**.

Throughout the month culture seekers can visit the **Royal Opera House** for a variety of experiences, including insightful discussions with the Principal Dancer of The Royal Ballet, Laura Morera, as well as conversations with the creatives behind Andrei Serban's colourful production of *Turandot*. Until 6th February, visitors can also experience a programme of lunchtime music recitals from artists from The Royal Opera and the Orchestra of the Royal Opera House hosted in the historic Crush Room. Family Sundays will also run at the Royal Opera House until 26th February where visitors can explore its artists and the



world of opera and ballet. Guests will also be able to enjoy dance workshops running from February to March, as well as new ballets and operas launching including *Sleeping Beauty, Tannhauser and the Barber of Seville*.

To celebrate in style across the Valentine's Weekend, Covent Garden, as one of the most romantic and most-loved neighbourhoods of London, is the perfect destination for date night activities, weekend breaks, or trips with friends. This half-term Covent Garden has a myriad of activities to keep the whole family entertained from pop-ups to family-friendly dining. In celebration of the 160 years of London's famous Tube network, visitors can step into the past and see the historic underground trains at the **London Transport Museum.** With free entry for children from 11th-19th February, there will be a number of games and craft activities throughout the whole month. For foodie families, visitors can stop at the East Piazza for pop-ups from **Gully, My Pie** and **Blondie's Kitchen.** British Street Food Awards finalist **Gully**, known for their Indian Street food, will be popping up from the 9th-26th February, offering consumers a chance to try their unique 'build your own' menu while combining spices, aromas and flavours of North Indian cuisine. **My Pie** will be popping up alongside serving a modern twist on the classic pie and mash, and from the 10th-26th February, Covent Garden favourite, **Blondies Kitchen**, will be bringing their Insta-famous truck to serve a larger offering of their bestsellers including their milk and cookies combo and more.
